Highlights:

- There are 87137 confirmed cases of COVID-19 spreading over 58 countries with 2977 deaths globally as of March 01, 2020
- Azerbaijan, Ecuador, Ireland, Monaco and Qatar reported its first cases of COVID-19
- Cases continue to rise in countries outside of China as compared to within China
- No new suspected case of COVID-19 reported from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa today

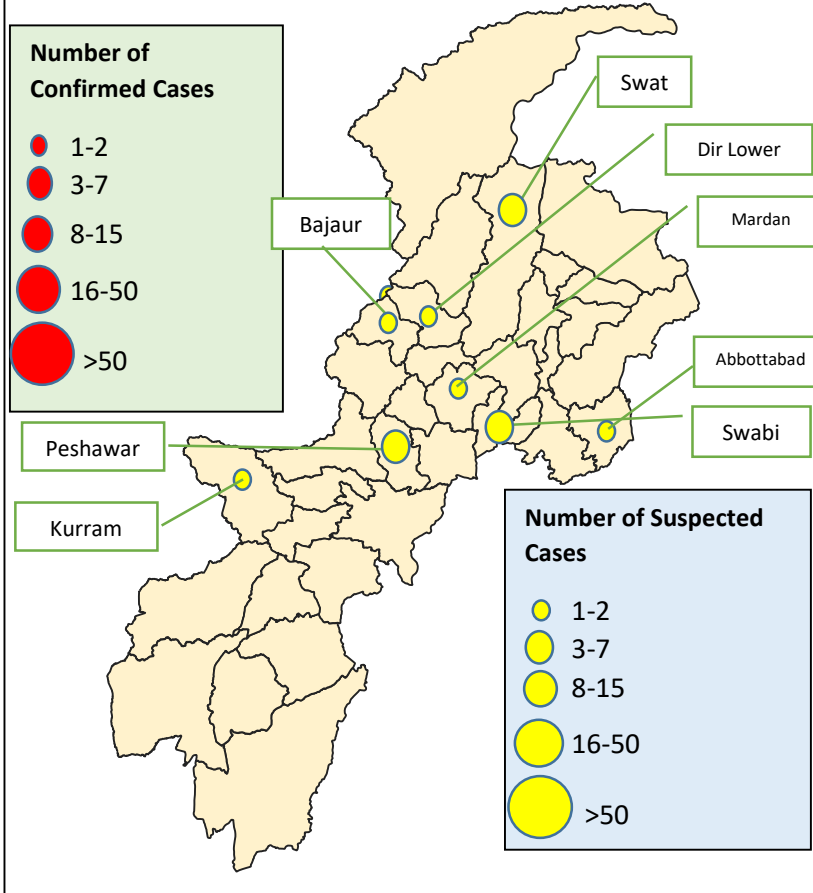

Preparedness, Response & Updates:

1. Draft for COVID-19 Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Action Plan developed by Health Department
2. Constitution of advisory and technical committees at provincial and district level to oversight, steer and monitor activities related to preparedness and response for COVID-19
3. As a high vigilance measure, 35 Persons who travelled from Iran in last 14 days have been contacted for presence of any signs and symptoms
4. Health Department has deputed 31 health staff at Peshawar Airport to facilitate Airport authorities for screening and reporting of cases
5. Ongoing screening of suspected cases of COVID-19 continues at Peshawar International Airport and Pak-Afghan border entry points
6. Field epidemiologists at stand-by for epidemiological interventions and contact tracing of any reported suspected case

Advice for Public:

1. Avoiding close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infection
2. If you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing seek medical care early
3. Frequent hand washing especially after direct contact with ill people or their environment
4. People with symptoms of acute respiratory infection should cover their coughing and sneezing with disposable tissue and practice hand washing afterwards, if you don't have a tissue cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands
5. Avoid frequent travel and crowds
6. Within healthcare facilities enhance standard infection, prevention and control practices
