Situation Report-41 Khyber Pakhtunkhwa



Highlights:

- COVID-19 spreading over 143 countries/Territories/areas with 5735 deaths globally as of 15-03-2020
- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa reported its first 15 confirmed cases of COVID-19 with Sindh cases reaching 103, making the number of confirmed cases of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan to 136.
- 6 new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa today
- Four previously reported suspected cases of COVID-19 from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (1) from DHQ Kohat and (3) from Police and Services Hospital Peshawar have been declared negative after laboratory confirmation

Provincial Updates:

- Two new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from Police and Services Hospital Peshawar. Standard protocols for isolation, case reporting, sample transport and case management followed.
- Four new suspected cases were reported, One each from Bacha Khan Medical Complex Swabi, DHO Office Abbottabad, DHQ Hospital Mardan and DHO Office Charsadda. Cases are isolated, specimen are collected for further investigations and required management is being offered.
- 3. An alert was generated (Referred from North West General Hospital) at Police and Services Hospital in Peshawar, which after thorough investigation and examination, was declared a false alert.
- 4. Training of 43 Doctors in High Dependency Units of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was conducted on infection control, disinfection and decontamination for COVID-19 with support from UNICEF.
- 5. Assessment of the isolation wards in 37 facilities have so far been conducted. This activity was facilitated by WHO.

District Updates:

- 1. An orientation session on COVID-19 was arranged for LHSs' and In-Charge Category D Hospital in Dir Upper.
- 2. Two alerts, generated from Buner, were investigated by the response team from DHO office and declared false alerts.
- 3. Identification and screening of people with recent travel history from Saudi Arabia done by health field staff in Lakki
- 4. Training of 150 Health Staff at Mansehra DHO office on IPC.
- 5. Decontamination and disinfection practices exercised inside Chinese settlement and at designated lay by area for the travelers from Iran
- 6. Orientation and preparedness session on COVID -19 was conducted by DHO Hangu, NSTOP Officers, DSO in Type D hospital Hangu
