

Highlights:

- COVID-19 spreading over 159 countries/Territories/areas with 7426 deaths globally as of 17-03-2020
- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa reported three new confirmed case from Police Hospital Peshawar/LRH (resident of Hangu), Hayatabad Medical Complex (resident of Buner), Mardan Medical Complex (resident of Mardan)
- All confirmed cases of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has international travel history
- 20 new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa today

Provincial Updates:

- 10 new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from DHO office Parachinar, District Kurram. They all have travel history of Iran. Standard protocols for isolation, case reporting, sample transport and case management followed
- 2. 10 new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from Abbottabad (2), Charsadda (1), Peshawar (4), Shangla (1), South Waziristan (1), and Swabi (1). All protocols for isolation, case reporting, sample transport and case management followed
- Workshop regarding awareness and prevention about COVID-19 was held in main head office of Health Care Commission
- Meeting under chair of Commissioner Malakand with DC and DHOs were conducted to review risk level & preparedness against COVID-19
- Total of 38 medical officer and women medical officers deputed in isolation wards trained on COVID-19 case management, infection prevention and control and risk communication
- Shifting of ventilators shifted to Mufti Mehmood Memorial Hospital D.I.Khan from DHO D.I.Khan, Lakki Marwat, Tank and DHQ Lakki
- Necessary logistics from DGHS office mobilized to all districts
