
### Highlights:

- COVID-19 spreading over 160 countries/Territories/areas with 7807 deaths globally as of 18-03-2020
- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa reported its first two deaths with one being reported from Mardan Medical Complex (resident of District Mardan) and other being reported from LRH (Resident of District Hangu)
- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa reported four new confirmed cases of COVID-19, with three of them being reported from Police and Services Hospital, Peshawar (Residence of Mansehra, Buner and District Khyber Respectively) and one being reported from DHQ Charsadda (Residence of Charsadda).
- 25 new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa today

- 2. Two previously reported suspected cases of COVID-19 from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (1) from Hayatabad Medical Complex have been declared negative after laboratory confirmation
- 3. Twenty Five new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. (3 from Police and Services Hospital, 4 from KTH, 4 from HMC, 1 from DHO Office Bajaur, 2 from DHO Office Upper Kurram, 6 from DHO Office Abbottabad, 2 from DHO Office Mardan, 1 from DHO Office Lakki Marwat and 1 from DHO Office Malakand) Standard protocols for isolation, case reporting, sample transport and case management followed.

## **District Updates:**

- 1. Screening of the contacts of positive case from Mardan was done and the close contacts were kept in quarantine with 3 samples taken of suspected cases and sent for laboratory confirmation.
- DHO Charsadda with support of District administration quarantined 20 household around positive case house. All the house hold members of the positive case were investigated and found healthy. Awareness message communicated to the community.
- 3. In district Khyber Rapid Response Team from health department and district administration visited the positive case house and investigated all the house hold, attached houses and made plan for quarantine of the area.
- 4. Contact tracing of the positive cases at District Hangu and Mansehra conducted.
