

Highlights:

Institute of Health

- There are 80239 confirmed cases of COVID-19 with 2700 deaths globally as of February 25, 2020.
- Outside of China there are 2459 confirmed cases (390 new) spreading over 33 countries including Pakistan neighboring countries of Iran and India.
- Afghanistan, Bahrain, Iraq and Oman are the latest countries to report its 1st case OF COVID-19.
 Previously reported 2 cases of COVID-19 from Swat have been declared negative from National

Preparedness, Response & Updates:

- Team from Health Directorate met with Medical Director of Lady Reading Hospital for establishment of High Dependency Unit for any suspected cases of COVID-19
- 2. All of the 16 suspected cases in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa so far have resulted negative from the laboratory
- 3. Alert of suspected COVID-19 was generated from Abbottabad and investigated by a team from DHO office where he was declared healthy and free of disease
- 4. With emergence of COVID-19 cases in Iran and Afghanistan, screening of all passengers entering to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from Iran and Afghanistan through any means is enhanced
- 5. As a high vigilance measure, 32 Persons who travelled from Iran in last 14 days have been contacted for presence of any signs and symptoms

Advice for Public:

- 1. Avoiding close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infection.
- 2. If you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing seek medical care early.
- 3. Frequent hand washing especially after direct contact with ill people or their environment
- 4. People with symptoms of acute respiratory infection should cover their coughing and sneezing with disposable tissue and practice hand washing afterwards, if you don't have a tissue cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands
- 5. Avoid frequent travel and crowds
- 6. Within healthcare facilities enhance standard infection, prevention and control practices
