Situation Report in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa



Highlights:

- There are 81109 confirmed cases of COVID-19 spreading over 38 countries with 2761 deaths globally as of February 26, 2020
- Pakistan reported its first 2 cases of COVID-19, one reported from Karachi and second from Islamabad. Algeria, Austria, Croatia and Switzerland are other countries to report COVID-19 case
- For the first time, since the first identified case of COVID-19 on December 08, 2019, more cases reported from countries outside of China than from China, with bulk of cases from Iran

Preparedness, Response & Updates:

- 1 new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from Police and Services Hospital, Peshawar. All protocols followed regarding isolation, case reporting, sample transport and case management
- 2. 4 Students from Haripur with travel history from China were referred to Police and Services Hospital, where they were investigated and declared healthy and free of disease
- 3. Lists of 306 persons from 10 districts with recent travel history to Iran shared with districts for investigation and contact tracing
- 4. Constitution of Rapid Response Teams in all districts of province
- 5. Initiation of establishment of High Dependency Unit in six high risk districts i.e. Peshawar, Kohat, Hangu, DIKhan, Orakzai and Kurram
- 6. Public Health Laboratory Khyber Pakhtunkhwa operationalized for testing of Corona virus
- 7. Isolation beds and services enhanced for an anticipated outbreak
- 8. MTI hospitals of Peshawar instructed to enhance hospital preparedness measures in case of escalation of situation

Advice for Public:

- 1. Avoiding close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infection
- 2. If you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing seek medical care early
- 3. Frequent hand washing especially after direct contact with ill people or their environment
- 4. People with symptoms of acute respiratory infection should cover their coughing and sneezing with disposable tissue and practice hand washing afterwards, if you don't have a tissue cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands
- 5. Avoid frequent travel and crowds
- 6. Within healthcare facilities enhance standard infection, prevention and control practices
