

## **Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19)**

**Situation Report in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**

### Highlights:

- There are 82294 confirmed cases of COVID-19 spreading over 46 countries with 2804 deaths globally as of February 27, 2020
- Brazil, Denmark, Estonia, Georgia, Greece, Norway, Romania and North Macedonia reported first confirmed case of COVID-19
- 1 new suspected cases of COVID-19 reported from District Kurram. All protocols followed regarding isolation, case reporting, sample transport and case management
- Previously reported case of COVID-19 from Police and Services Hospital, Peshawar has been declared negative from National Institute of Health (NIH) Islamabad





## Preparedness, Response & Updates:

- 1. As a high vigilance measure, 22 Persons who travelled from Iran in last 14 days have been contacted for presence of any signs and symptoms
- 2. As per details shared with districts, passengers with recent travel to Iran are advised for self-quarantine and isolated in hospitals
- Alert of suspected COVID-19 was generated from Airport and was referred to Police and Services Hospital Peshawar where he was declared healthy and free of disease
- Alert of suspected COVID-19 was generated from Peshawar and was investigated by a team from DHO office where he was declared healthy and free of disease
- Biosafety training was conducted in KTH, HMC and Airport to orient the concerned staff about infection prevention and control strategies regarding COVID-19

# Torghar Advice for Public:

- Avoiding close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infection
- 2. If you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing seek medical care early

- 3. Frequent hand washing especially after direct contact with ill people or their environment
- 4. People with symptoms of acute respiratory infection should cover their coughing and sneezing with disposable tissue and practice hand washing afterwards, if you don't have a tissue cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands
- 5. Avoid frequent travel and crowds
- 6. Within healthcare facilities enhance standard infection, prevention and control practices
