Situation Report in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa



Highlights of today:

- There are 83652 confirmed cases of COVID-19 spreading over 51 countries with 2858 deaths globally as of February 28, 2020
- Two (02) new cases confirmed in Pakistan (1 in Karachi and 1 in Rawalpindi)
- Belarus, Lithuania, Netherlands, New Zealand and Nigeria reported its first cases of COVID-19
- Cases continue to rise in countries outside of China as compared to within China
- WHO Risk Assessment at Regional and Global Level has been raised from High to Very High

Preparedness, Response & Updates:

- 1. Alerts of suspected COVID-19 was generated from Nowshera, DIKhan and Mardan, who were investigated by teams from DHO office and declared healthy and free of disease.
- 2. High profile meeting under the chairmanship of Advisor to PM on Health regarding stocktake, preparedness and future strategies. All provinces were represented through Chief Secretaries via video link.
- 3. More than 200 people with recent travel history to Iran have been tracked by District Administration and District Health Offices.
- 4. 6 suspected COVID-19 cases were referred (1 from Jail and 5 Self Referred) to Police and Services Hospital in Peshawar and were investigated; all were declared healthy and free of disease.
- 5. Health Department has deputed 31 health staff at Peshawar Airport to facilitate Airport authorities for screening and reporting of cases.
- 6. High vigilance with staff presence continues at field from Directorate General Health Services on weekend.

Advice for Public:

- 1. Avoiding close contact with people suffering from acute respiratory infection
